On Day 2, IAF duo land at Yangon

Wg Cdr Rahul Monga and Wg Cdr Anil Kumar landed in Yangon around 16:45 hours on the second day of their *Round the World Expedition* in a microlight aircraft. The duo is going to halt overnight at Yangon before taking off for Bangkok on Sunday morning.

The men in uniform had taken off from Mandalay in Myanmar around 14:30 hours.

Earlier, in a conversation with *Indiatimes News Network* via satellite phone at 14:20 hours, Wg Cdr Rahul Monga, the leader of the expedition, said that everything was going fine.

However, he did mention that the duo had to climb to high altitude (incidentally they soared 12,000 feet as against 10,000 decided by them) because of heavy cloud cover in the skies.

The duo had left Bagdogra early Saturday morning and landed in Guwahati for their last stop in India. They left Guwahati around 9 am and were on their way to Myanmar.

Wg Cdr Monga, while cruising in the skies around 3 am, had this to say on his blog: "A big day ahead. It will be the first time that any Indian micro will leave the borders for a foreign land. We have to be careful of weather. The terrain is hilly and weather and hills do not go together. It's 3 in the morning. Will now go to file clearance and prepare the aircraft."
