## Day 26: No flying, courtesy bad weather

NEW DELHI: The IAF *Round the World Expedition* remained stuck in Nikolaevsk on Tuesday as the destination Okhotsk is facing bad weather.

According to latest reports reaching here, although the weather at Nikolaevsk is fine, the cloud over the hilly areas around the destination makes it dangerous for visual flying.

The Russian leg of the expedition is right now being handled by only Wg Cdr Monga as Russian Air Traffic Control converses in Russian alone and it is therefore mandatory to have a Russian speaking navigator in the machine.

The other pilot, Wing Commander Anil Kumar will meet the expedition when it reaches Alaska, if all goes well, another 4 days from now.
