The Round the World Expedition landed at its destination Chaybukha on Tuesday at 07:57 IST

NEW DELHI: After being stuck for four consecutive days, the Round the World Expedition took off from Magadan in Russia on Tuesday at 04:40 IST. The aircraft landed at its destination Chaybukha on Tuesday at 07:57 IST.

According to reports reaching here, the microlight is currently running 12 days behind schedule.

If weather permits, the microlight will take off from Chaybukha on Wednesday at 04:00 IST to reach its next destination Markovo, Russia at 07:22 IST.

The Russian leg of the expedition is right now being handled only by Wg Cdr Monga as Russian Air Traffic Control converses in Russian alone and it is therefore mandatory to have a Russian speaking navigator in the machine.

The other pilot, Wing Commander Anil Kumar will meet the expedition when it reaches Alaska.
