Round the World Expedition landed at Markovo in Russia at 07:10 IST on Wednesday

NEW DELHI: The Round the World Expedition landed at Markovo in Russia at 07:10 IST on Wednesday after taking off from Chaybukha at 03:46 IST.

With strong winds blowing at Markovo, the weather conditions are not favourable for the microlight to take off to its next destination Anadyr, Russia on Wednesday.

If weather permits, the microlight will take off from Markovo on Thursday at 08:30 IST to land at Anadyr at 10:33 IST.

According to the reports, the expedition will go through two legs on Thursday. If climatic conditions are favourable, the first leg will take the aircraft to its next destination, Anadyr.

The second leg is when the microlight will enter Nome in United States from Russia.

The Russian leg of the expedition is right now being handled only by Wg Cdr Monga as Russian Air Traffic Control converses in Russian alone and it is therefore mandatory to have a Russian speaking navigator in the machine.

The other pilot, Wing Commander Anil Kumar will meet the expedition when it reaches Alaska.
