The RTW expedition has reached Snohomish for an overnight halt

The expedition is still hopeful of creating a World Record in circumnavigating the globe in the shortest possible time. It had originally planned for 64 days, but is delayed by over 12 days now. It is still in line to break the 99 days existing record though.

NEW DELHI: The IAF RTW expedition had a good day in the office on Saturday when the duo of Wing Cdrs, Rahul Monga and Anil Kumar landed at Snohomish for an overnight halt. The duo had reached Bellingham in US from Canada at 7:40 IST.

The stop at Snohomish completes over 8 hours flying for the duo. This has been one of their longest days in office since the expedition began.

The duo had earlier taken a fuel stop over at Prince George in Canada.

The expedition has been hamstrung by poor weather over China, Russia and then Alaska after it entered US by flying over Bering Sea.
