The IAF RTW expedition is ready to reach Inukjuak in Canada

NEW DELHI: The IAF RTW expedition landed at La Grande Riviere airport in Canada at 21:10 IST on Thursday evening.

The microlite will take off from La Grande Riviere at around 21:00 IST on Friday to reach its next destination Inukjuak in Canada, as it moves north towards the Atlantic Ocean to cross into Greenland.

According to reports reaching here, the weather looks absolutely fine and there should be no problem in the flight.

The IAF pilots are already 12 days behind schedule - thanks to extremely poor weather over China and Russia and also in Alaska.

The duo of Wing Cdrs Rahul Monga and Anil Kumar had planned to recover some of the lost days, but bad weather seems to have put paid to such hopes currently. The fact that the aircraft is small and prone to elements does not make things simple.

The pilots had taken off from Hindan air base near Delhi on June 1.
