NEW DELHI: The IAF RTW expedition gets ready for some real tough flying over the next two days. According to the latest reports reaching here, the pilot duo of Wing Cdrs Rahul Monga and Anil Kumar are waiting for the weather to clear at Le Grande.

Right now (it is early morning there), Le Grande weather is overcast with clouds hanging at 500 and 1000 feet combined with intermittent rains. It is expected to improve in three to four hours from now according to the forecast.

Once the weather clears, the duo will take off for Iqualuit, which will take eight hours. But their plane is topped up with fuel for only six hours and that would necessitate a refuel stop at Inukjuak.

If all goes well, the IAF duo will be there at Inukjuak by 2330 UTC provided they have fair winds and fine weather by their side.
