NEW DELHI: The Round the World expedition is still in Iqaluit, Canada due to reports of bad weather in their next destination in Greenland.

The expedition would have preferred to reach Greenland after flying over the Baffin Sea on Saturday itself, but the pilot duo faced bad weather over Iqaluit. This forced the duo to stay on in Inukjuak that day.

On Sunday, they did plan to fly further, but there were low clouds over Iqaluit.
