Day 65: RTW progresses, but still in Iceland

NEW DELHI: The IAF RTW expedition took off from Reykjavik in Iceland at 15:19 hrs IST on Saturday for Vagar in Denmark.

However, bad weather forced the sole pilot, Wing Cdr Rahul Monga to land at a remote Eastern corner of Iceland called Hofn, which is virtually mid-way to its destination, Vagar. Onward flying to Vagar will completely depend on weather conditions.

The expedition had reached Reykjavik in Iceland at 03:19 hrs IST on Friday after taking off from Kulusuk, Greenland.

The expedition is led by Wing Cdr Rahul Monga with Wing Cdr Anil Kumar as his co-pilot. But owing to extra load over high seas, Monga is flying solo between Iqaluit and the UK.

The expedition is already running 16 days behind schedule, which includes four rest days.

They had taken off from Hindan air base near Delhi on June 1.
