Day 66: RTW heads towards Scotland

The IAF RTW expedition took off from Hofn at the Eastern Edge of Iceland around 1430 Hrs IST and would head straight for a Royal Air Force base near Aberdeen in Scotland.

The expedition had to make an unscheduled stop at Hofn after it took off from Reykjavik the day before on its way to Vagar in Denmark. However, poor weather over Vagar forced a stop in the remote Hofn village.

And since the weather is still poor over Vagar, Wing Cdr Rahul Monga, who is flying solo till the expedition reaches UK, has decided to skip Vagar altogether.

Wing Cdr Anil Kumar will now meet Monga at Scotland.

According to latest information, the weather is barely good enough and the pilot is flying extremely low, "almost hugging the surface" to avoid turbulence.
