## Day 67: RTW lands at Eggersdorf

NEW DELHI: The IAF duo, of Wing Cdr Rahul Monga and Wing Cdr Anil Kumar as his co-pilot, landed at Eggersdorf in Germany at 21:10 hrs IST on Monday. The IAF RTW Expedition was airborne from Munster, Germany at 18:47 hrs IST on Monday, covering a distance of 444 km.

The aircraft will take off from Eggersdorf at 11:30 hrs IST on Tuesday to reach its next destination Friedrichshafen, Germany. The pilots have plans to complete two legs on Tuesday. If weather permits, the microlight will fly to Samedan in Switzerland from Friedrichshafen on the same day.

Just a couple of days earlier Wing Cdr Monga flew into hall of aviation fame by becoming the first Indian to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean in a single engine small aircraft.

The expedition is already running 14 days behind schedule.

They had taken off from Hindan air base near Delhi on June 1.
