Day 68: RTW still at Eggersdorf

NEW DELHI: The IAF RTW expedition did not fly on Tuesday due to aircraft servicing. Currently, the microlite is at Eggersdorf in Germany.

On Monday, the IAF duo of Wing Cdr Rahul Monga and Wing Cdr Anil Kumar as his co-pilot, landed at Eggersdorf at 21:10 hrs IST. The IAF RTW Expedition was airborne from Munster, Germany at 18:47 hrs IST on Monday, covering a distance of 444 km.

If weather permits, the aircraft will take off from Eggersdorf at around 12:00 hrs IST on Wednesday to reach its next destination Friedrichshafen, Germany.

The expedition is already running late by 14 days.

Just a few days earlier, Wing Cdr Monga flew into hall of aviation fame by becoming the first Indian to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean in a single engine small aircraft.

The expedition is already running 14 days behind schedule. They had taken off from Hindan air base near Delhi on June 1.
