NEW DELHI: Praying for clear weather, the IAF RTW expedition is still at Eggersdorf in Germany. It has been a full day since the pilots have been waiting for a clear weather window. On Tuesday, they did not fly due to servicing of the aircraft.

If weather permits, the aircraft will take off from Eggersdorf to reach its next destination Friedrichshafen, Germany.

On Monday, Wing Cdr Rahul Monga and Wing Cdr Anil Kumar, landed at Eggersdorf at 21:10 hrs IST. The IAF RTW Expedition was airborne from Munster, Germany at 18:47 hrs IST on Monday, covering a distance of 444 km.
